

Patient Shopping List

Please have these items before your procedure

- Gentle Cleanser
 - We recommend Cetaphil Gentle Cleanser
- White Distilled Vinegar
 - Helps as a natural astringent and defoliant accelerator, also helps kill bacteria on the skin
- Large tub of Vaseline or Aquaphor
 - Works as a protective barrier and moisture occlusion for the skin
- Eucerin, Cerave or Cetaphil Moisturizing Cream
 - Used to protect the skin from infection and aid the skin to heal
- Soft Gel Face Masks, Ice Packs, Small bags of frozen peas
 - Helps swelling subside and used for personal comfort
- Ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin (ONLY if patient CANNOT take Vicodin/Hydrocodone)
 - Helps with pain control and inflammation
- Hydrocortisone Cream or Benadryl
 - To be used under the Vaseline/Aquaphor for no more than 2 days
 - Helps reduce inflammation and itching

Dr. Shin will prescribe 1 week before your procedure

- Valtrex
- Keflex
- Vicodin
- Valium

Day of FX Procedure

- Please read and sign all consent forms that are provided at the time of appointment
- Photographs will be taken
- Hair needs to be pulled back before the procedure
- Areas will be cleansed and numbed with a topical medication for 45 minutes

During the FX Procedure

- The topical anesthetic will be taken off
- Either laser protection goggles or metal protectors will be placed on your eyes
- The procedure will take approximately 60 to 90 minutes

Pre-Procedure

Remember to follow these instructions before your procedure

- Eat a meal
- Bring a sunhat
- Take all recommended vitamins and prescribed medications
- Shower and wash your face
- Wear a loose, cotton, garment top
- No make-up or lotions on face
- No jewelry
- Shop for your post-laser supplies

MEN

- Must shave before your procedure

Helpful Hints

- Have a fan handy to help cool the feeling of extreme sunburn to the face
- Sleep with your head slightly elevated for the first couple of days
- If the Vicodin is too strong, take it with food.
 - Be sure to take some Valium before bedtime to ensure a good night's sleep. Make sure to finish all prescribed medications as directed

Patient Medication

Dr. Shin will prescribe these medications 1 week before your procedure
Remember to bring your medications to your appointment

- **Valtrex**
 - An anti-viral medication
 - Lasers can stimulate a breakout on your lips, face or elsewhere, Keflex is used to treat cold sores and herpetic outbreaks
 - Start Valtrex 2 days prior to procedure and continue for 5 days
- **Keflex**
 - An antibiotic medication
 - Used to treat infections caused by bacteria
- **Vicodin and Valium**
 - For discomfort relief during the procedure
- *You will have to come in for your Post-Operative appointments*
- *Your skin is FIVE times more susceptible to the sun's UV rays, make sure to use SPF 30 or above, wear sunglasses and a sunhat when going out*
- *Alert the office immediately if you have an allergic reaction to any of the medications prescribed*

MEDICATIONS TO AVOID AND OTHER PRECAUTIONS

- Aspirin or any medications that contain aspirin
- Anti-inflammatory medications
- All nutritional supplements
 - Vitamin C and E, flaxseed, fish oil and herbal teas
 - Large amounts of green tea and garlic
- Stop Accutane 1 year prior
- Stop Retin-A and Triluma 1 week prior
- No dermal filler for a month prior
- Cannot be pregnant, breast feeding, or on fertility medications

What to expect after your procedure:

- *Several hours of a hot "sunburnt" feeling*
- *Swelling of the face and or eyes*
- *Extreme redness*
- *Pin point bleeding/ scabbing*
- *Weeping/ oozing*
- *Itching*
- *Acne/ Milia breakouts*
- *Heat/ sun sensitivity*
- *Blistering*
- *Nausea*
- *Bad odor to treated skin as it defoliates*
- *Extreme dryness*

Remember to clear your schedule for several days after your FX Treatment

- You will need to use UVA and UVB blocking agents on a regular basis
- Avoid tretinoin (Retin A) products and alpha hydroxyl acid for 3 weeks
- You may resume your exercise routine after DAY 10, or when Dr. Shin deems you are ready

- A driver is expected to wait or be available when prompted
- Remember to take medications after arriving at office
